- We don't have *much* oil, but we have *lots of / a lot of* milk.



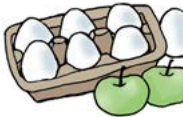
- *How many* carrots and peas do we have?
- We don't have *many* carrots, but we have *lots of / a lot of* peas.



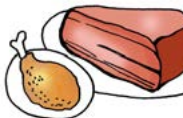
- *How much* sugar and salt do we have?
